Notes on method

- Courses were matched strictly by course code between each program's course of study and the Fall 2026 Section Schedule. Where a series is split (e.g., HS 111 offered but HS 112 not; AC 301/303 offered but AC 302 not; WT 214 offered but WT 213 not), only the specific unscheduled code is listed.
- Physical Arts (PA 3X1/3X2/3X3): Tai Chi (PA 301–303, 306) and Qi Gong (PA 321–324) ARE offered; Hatha Yoga (PA 311–315) is not — the physical-arts requirement remains satisfiable.

- Generic “Elective” slots are omitted (they can be filled from offered electives); only named elective courses appear above.
- Several codes are shared across programs (shared core); each program is disclosed independently so its roster is complete. Program 3 therefore repeats the Acupuncture items and adds the herbal-specialization and alumni-track courses.
- For reference, these commonly-confused codes ARE offered in Fall 2026: HS 301 (A&P I), CH 301 (Intro to Chinese Herbal Medicine), and C 504 (Oriental Medicine Clinic IV).
